MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

Each group will create a ten to fifteen minute video on the topic of hand. [Max. 20 minutes]

- The video must follow the country through World War I and/or II.
- Through a created storyline, each group must:
 - Discuss at least ten general facts and figures.
 - Discuss at least one battle in which your country was involved.
 - Discuss at least one piece of important legislation.
 - Discuss at least one important point during the war for your country.
 - Discuss the outcome of the war for your country.
- Each group will create a poster board storyboard that will outline their video by scenes. A 8x11.5 outline will be due on March 19, 2013. The large storyboard will be due on the day of the video submissions.
- Each group member will provide a half page summary of their contributions to the group. They will also include a pie graph at the bottom of their summary to show the percentage of contribution per group member. If all members contributed equally, you do not need to divide up the pie graph, rather just write, “EQUAL” in the pie graph.
- The video must be provided on a standard **VHS, DVD or .mov or .mp4 File (flash drive)** – no other format will be accepted!! Please contact me if you need assistance transferring the video to VHS, DVD or digital format.
- Each group member will submit a **separate individually completed** one page paper about the country they researched with three sources!!
- The due date for the video is: April 9, 2013.
